



ENCOMPASSING MORE THAN 2,100 ACRES OF rugged, heavily forested, mountainous terrain, **Bluestone State Park** provides a wide variety of water-oriented activities for guests and residents of southern West Virginia. In the midst of this wilderness park, just five miles south of Hinton, are nestled modern cabins, campgrounds and fine recreational facilities. The extra plus is that Bluestone is adjacent to Bluestone Lake, the state's third largest body of water.

Due to this sizeable lake, boating and fishing are naturally an important part of the recreational opportunities at the park. The addition of hiking trails, a swimming pool, game courts, and a seasonal nature/recreation program creates a well-rounded array of activities. The proximity of Bluestone to Winter Place ski area makes the park's rental cabins affordable accommodations for ski groups and winter vacations.

Historical and recreational interest located in the Bluestone area includes the outdoor musical dramas "Hatfields and McCoys" and others shows performed at Grandview Park, near Beckley. Pipestem Resort with its myriad recreational facilities is only nine miles to the south. Just north of the park are Bluestone Dam, Historic Hinton, and the New River Gorge National River, center of some of the state's best whitewater rafting and canoeing. Of special note are Sandstone Falls and the Visitor Center, just north of Hinton; and Bluestone National Wild and Scenic River, which flows into Bluestone Lake within the park boundaries. Hunting and fishing opportunities abound at 17,632-acre Bluestone Wildlife Management Area adjacent to the park and nearby Camp Creek State Forest.

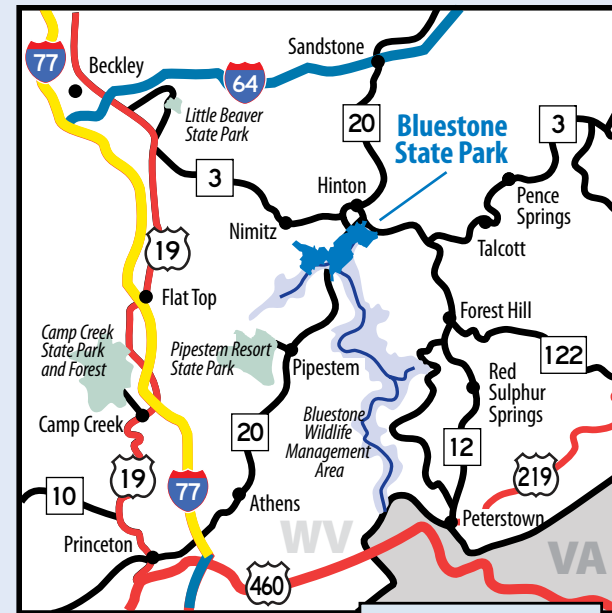

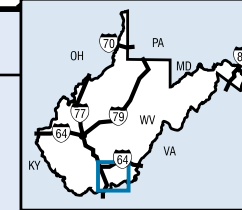

LOCATION

Located in the southeastern section of the state, Bluestone State Park is accessible by several major highways. Take Exit 139 (Sandstone/Hinton) off Interstate 64 to state Route 20, south, and drive 15 miles to the park. From the south on Interstate 77, take Exit 14 (Athens Road Exit) to state Route 20, north, and travel 22 miles to the park.

CABIN RESERVATION INFORMATION

Cabins at Bluestone State Park are open year-round. During summer months cabins may be reserved for up to two weeks from the second Monday in June through mid-August. Weekly rentals run from Monday, check-in through the following Monday, check-out. Bluestone also offers rental options of less than seven nights, which include three- and four-night stays.

Getaways and vacations are popular in the fall, winter and spring months. During these times cabins may be rented by the day and two-day weekends or longer.

Reservations may be made up to one year in advance from the first day in the month and are recommended at all times. Cabin reservations for four or more nights require a deposit of one-half the rental fee with the balance due upon arrival; rentals of three nights or less, the full rental fee is required.

Reservations made by phone will be held for 10 days to allow time to remit the required deposit if personal check or money order is the payment method. Payment by credit card is processed at the time of the reservation. Reservations made less than 10 days prior to the arrival date, as available, are accommodated and a method of guarantee provided at the time the reservation is made. Identification and proof of age may be requested.

Reservations may be made by calling Bluestone State Park directly or by dialing 1-800-CALL WVA and asking for Bluestone State Park. This toll-free line may be used anywhere in the continental United States or any Canadian province in the Eastern time zone.

CAMPGROUND & CAMPSITE RESERVATION INFORMATION

There are 18 sites designated for reservations at Bluestone State Park. The remaining sites are rented on a first-come, first-served basis. Campsite reservations are taken in advance for designated reservable sites from the Friday before Memorial Day through Labor Day. Outside the reservable dates, all sites become first-come, first-served basis.

Only mail-in reservations will be accepted from February 15 through March 14. Application forms for the current



year are available online to download. Mail-in reservations must be postmarked on or after February 15, or they will be returned. A maximum of three reservation forms per envelope will be accepted. Envelopes received with more than three reservation forms will be returned. Call-in requests during the period of February 15 – March 15 will be sent blank reservations forms and instructions regarding return of completed forms and payments. Beginning March 15, phone reservations will be accepted during office hours. Mail-in, call-in and walk-in reservations will be accepted from April 1 through Labor Day Weekend.

Reserved campsites that are accessible to persons with disabilities will be held for such individuals to reserve from February 15 through March 14. Proof of disability must accompany the deposit, and the site must be occupied during the reservation period by the disabled individual for the reservation to be honored. Beginning March 15, the sites will become available for all rentals. All other current reservation procedures besides those described above will remain the same. A minimum of two nights, up to a maximum of 14 nights, is required when making a reservation.

Campsite reservations must be made two (2) or more days in advance, as available, and must be secured by payment of a deposit of the entire rental fee, plus a \$5 handling charge. Campsite numbers will not be guaranteed; however, every effort will be made to assign the campsite requested. Only one camping unit per site is permitted. Reservations and



further information may be obtained by writing or calling the park directly.

PAYMENT METHODS

Payment for advance reservations for cabins and campsites may be made with personal check, money order or major credit card. Major credit cards accepted are VISA, MasterCard, American Express, Discover and Diners Club. Payments for balances due or other purchases when at Bluestone State Park are with cash, money order, or major credit card only. Identification may be required.

CANCELLATIONS

Cabins. In case of cabin cancellations, deposits will be returned (except for a \$20 handling fee), if notice is given at least 30 days in advance.

Campsites. Campsite reservations canceled more than seven days in advance, the deposit will be refunded with the exception of the handling fee plus the first night's rental. If canceled seven days or less in advance, no refund will be issued.
